This wooden bodied coach was built in the year 1921 by Braithwaite & Co. India Ltd. to commemorate the arrival of H.R.H. the Prince of Wales to India for the Royal Darbar. H.R.H. The Prince of Wales travelled in this carriage during 1921-22 for the inaugural ceremony of the Royal Indian Military College, Dehradun. This Coach had been in service on the Northern Railway till 1999 & it was formally handed over to the National Rail Museum, New Delhi in March 2000.

LOUNGE CAR

This coach was built in 1969 at Integral Coach Factory (ICF) Chennai. This was in service on the Northern Railway before it was handed over to National Rail Museum, New Delhi. This car was renovated by Divisional Railway Manager (DRM) Delhi Division in 2010 and handed over to Heritage Steam Loco Shed Rewari. Having capacity to accommodate 18 persons at a time for dining.
