**Sub.—Promotion of Class III staff against Selection posts.**

A copy of the Railway Board's letter No. E(NG) 61PM1-5, dated 28-9-1961 is forwarded for information and guidance. The Board's letters of 8-10-1958 and 22-1-1960 referred to therein were circulated under this office endorsement Nos. 831-E/63/2-III(Eiv), & 831-E/63/2-V(Eiv), dated 4-11-1958 & 16-7-1960 respectively.

**Sub.—Promotion of Class III staff against selection posts.**

Reference Railway Board's letter No. E(NG)56PM1-36, dated 22-1-1960 regarding automatic empanelment in the intermediate grade selection post, of an employee who is selected for a higher grade selection post. It has been represented to the Board that an employee of the type referred to would stand to lose in seniority to another employee who is not selected for the higher grade post but has been ranked as "outstanding" in the panel for the intermediate grade selection post in terms of this office letter No. E(NG)57PM1-24, dated 8-10-1958. The Board have considered the question and, in partial modification of their letter No. E (NG)56PM1-36, dated 22-1-1960 have decided that if the Selection Board for the intermediate grade selection post have placed some persons as "outstanding" in that case, an employee selected for a higher grade Class III Selection post or a Class II post in his normal channel of promotion may be deemed to have been classified as "outstanding" and given due place in accordance with his seniority amongst those classified by the Selection Board as "Outstanding" for the intermediate grade selection post, provided the selection for that post is held after such an employee has already been selected for the higher grade selection post.

(This finally disposes of Northern Railway's letter No. 831-E/63/2-VI(Eiv), dated 19-1-1961, Eastern Railway's letter No. E.1023/O/1, dated 26-4-1961 and Southern Railways' letter No. P(S) 535/II/2, dated 4-7-1961).

**Sub.—Classification of Non-gazetted posts as "Selection or Non-selection" Consequent on revision of pay structure.**

A copy of Railway Board's letter No. E(NG)61PM1-39, dated 12-9-1961 is forwarded for information and guidance.

As there is no post of Draftsmen/Estimators in grade Rs. 250-380 (A.S.) on this Railway, it has been recommended to the Railway Board that the posts of Head Draftsmen/Estimators etc. in grade Rs. 335-485 (A.S.) in the Drawing Offices in the Engineering Branches of all Departments be classified as "Selection" post. Pending availability of their decision, status quo should continue but holding of fresh selection for such post should pend.

**Sub.—Classification of non-gazetted posts as selection or non-selection, consequent on revision of pay structure.**

In some cases, two existing scales of pay for a category have been replaced by a single scale under the revised pay structure. This has necessitated
