Recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay

A Special Compensatory (Hill Area) Allowance

Recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission - Revision of rates.

The recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission relating to the Special Compensatory (Hill Area) Allowance have been considered by the Government. The President is pleased to decide that, in modification of this Ministry's letter No. F(E)64/AL-4/4 dated 6.7.64 as amended from time to time, letter No. F(E)I/98/AL-4/8 dated 13.10.98 and No.F(E)I/2005/AL-4/4 dated 21.2.06, Special Compensatory (Hill Area) Allowance to the Railway amployees shall be admissible at the following rates:-

Category Category	(Rate per month in Rs.) Altitude of the place at 1000 Metres and above Mean Sea Level
For posts in the grade pay of Rs.5400 and above and pay scale of HAG+ and above	600/-
For posts in the grace pay of less than Rs.5400/-	480/-

- In case of those employees who opt to retain the pre-revised scale of pay, the corresponding Grade Pay of the pay scale / corresponding pay scale of the post occupied on 1.1.2006, as indicated in Railway Services (Ravised Pay) Rules, 2008 would determine the allowance under these orders.
- The rate of this allowance shall automatically increase by 25% whenever the Dearness Allowance payable on the revised pay structure goes up by 50%.
- All other terms and conditions governing the grant of Special Compensatory (Hill Area) Allowance shall continue to be applicable.
