

2. The Govt. of India have now reviewed the question of continuance of the concession and have decided that it should be continued for a further period of eight months *i.e.* upto the end of March, 1962 on the same terms and conditions.

3. In so far as persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders have been issued in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General.

Sub.—Implementation of the recommendations of the Central Pay Commission—Daily rated workshop staff.

A copy of Railway Board's letter No. E(S)55CPC/83, dated 19-9-1961 is reproduced below for information and guidance:—

“In the case of daily-rated workshop staff brought on to monthly rates on the introduction of C.P.C. scales of pay, it was laid down in para. 1(6) of Board's letter No. E49CPC/129 dated, 10-10-1949 that for purpose of calculation of subscription and Spl. contribution to the State Railway Provident Fund/Gratuity, the monthly emoluments will be the monthly rate of pay. A question has been raised whether in the case of the workshop staff, who were monthly-rated prior to 1-1-1947, the emoluments for subscriptions etc. should be as defined in rule 1302(5)-RI or as laid down in para. 6 of the Board's letter referred to. It has been decided that for the purpose of calculation of subscription and special contribution to the State Railway Provident Fund/Gratuity, in their case also, the monthly emoluments will be the monthly rate of pay.

Cases dealt with otherwise, however, need not be re-opened.
