**Sub.**—Carry forward of earned leave/leave on average pay in the case of temporary/Government Railway servants transferred from civil to Railway Department or vice versa.

The Railway Board with the approval of the President have decided that the orders contained in their letter No. F(E)59/LE1/4/1, dated 21-6-1961 circulated vide this office letter No. 433-E/51(Eiv), dated 29-7-1961 will take effect from 28-10-1959.

**Sub.**—Study leave/extra-ordinary leave—bonds to be executed before the grant of Amount of penalty recoverable from the Railway servant in the event of non-fulfilment of his obligation to Government.

Reference Railway Board letter No. F(E)60/LE-9/(1), dated 5-7-1961 and the form of the bond to be executed by the temporary Railway servants granted extra ordinary leave in relaxation of Rule 732-RI for study in India or abroad, circulated vide this office letter No. 831-E/21(Eiv), dated 1-8-1961. The Railway Board have decided that temporary railway servants concerned shall be required to serve the Government for three years after rejoining duty.

This has the sanction of the President.

**Sub.**—Fixation of pay of ex. Non-combatant clerks of Military accounts Department on subsequent appointment to Civil posts.

**Sub.**—Fixation of pay of ex. Non-combatant clerks of Military Accounts Department, on subsequent appointment to civil posts.

In terms of para. 1 (ii) of Ministry of Finance O.M. No. F6(38)EIII/50, dated 18-1-1951 received under Railway Board's letter No. E52REI/1/3, dated 11-9-1951 the pay of persons who were holding posts of upper division clerks in the Military Accounts Department on the prescribed scale of pay of Rs. 80-220 and had subsequently been appointed in Civil offices as lower division clerks in P.S. Rs. 55-130 was to be fixed under clause I but with reference to the pay that they would have drawn in the Military Accounts Department if the prescribed scale (Rs. 55-130) of Lower /3rd Division had been prescribed for the upper Division posts in that Department.
