

Railways and have now decided, in partial supersession of the previous orders on the subject, that the Telephone Operators (including the Head Telephone Operators in authorised scale Rs. 210-320) should be granted special pay at the rate of 10% of pay subject to a minimum of Rs. 15/- p.m in the authorised scales of pay. These orders take effect from 1-11-1961.

The above has the sanction of the President."

Sub.—Headquarters Station of Railway servants in Delhi Area.

In accordance with the decision contained in Ex. C.A.O. 'R' E.P. Rly. letter No. 39E/O (Eii), dated 22-1-1949 (copy enclosed) the headquarters station of the Railway employees serving in the Delhi area for the purpose of claiming T.A. is Delhi main station.

With the increase in traffic at the Delhi main station some trains do not touch Delhi main and start from or terminate at New Delhi station. It has, therefore, been decided in consultation with the F.A. & C.A.O. N. Rly. that where the trains do not touch Delhi Main station, the departure and arrival time of a train at the New Delhi station may be taken into consideration for the purpose of claiming T.A. under rule 208/R1 excluding journeys on transfer.

Sub.—Headquarters of Railway servants in Delhi Area.

The Chief Administrative officer has under rule 218-R prescribed that the Headquarters of all E.P. Railway staff serving in the Delhi area shall be Delhi Main Station.

This decision is to be given immediate effect and the staff should be notified accordingly.
