Sub.—Incentives to Railway employees/apprentices acquiring higher or additional professional qualifications.

A copy of Railway Board's letter No. E(NG)58RC1/143, dated 17-2-1962 is reproduced below for information and guidance :—

"Reference item (v) of Board's letter No. E(NG)58RC1/143, dated 24-9-1960 and their further letter of 12-5-1961.

The Board have now decided that the benefits of Incentive Scheme should be made available to all the staff, permanent or temporary, irrespective of their working in the parent department or outside, in a cadre or an ex-cadre post.

3. As regards the staff of non-Accounts Departments working in the Accounts Department, the benefits of the Incentive Scheme will be available to the staff so long as they remain in the Accounts Department, but if the contingency of their reversion to the parent department does arise eventually, the benefits of two advance increments to them in the Accounts Department should be withdrawn, cash award already made not being recovered as has already been laid down in Board's letter of even number dated 23-10-1961.

These orders will have effect from the date of issue of Board's letter of even number dated 28-12-1959 and have the approval of the President."

It has been clarified by the Railway Board that the orders regarding the eligibility and calculation of daily allowance on percentage basis as laid down in para. 2 IV of their letter No. PC-60/TA-2/1, dated 22-5-1961 circulated under this office letter No. 39-E/O-V(Eiv), dated 6-6-1961, are also applicable to Casual Labour. The rates of daily allowance for Casual Labour have been specified in Board's letter No. PC-60/TA-2/1, dated 11-10-1961 circulated under this office letter No. 39-E/O-15(Eiv), dated 31-10-1961.
