**Sub.—**Revision of rules regarding treatment of running allowance as pay for certain purposes, consequent on revision of the pay structure w.e.f. 1-7-1959.

A copy of Railway Board's letter No. PC-60/RA.2/1, dated 16-3-1962 is reproduced below for information and guidance.

"Reference Board's letter of even number dated 11-12-1961. With a view to mitigate hardship to running staff who retired between 22-5-1961 and 1-11-1961 the Board have decided, with the approval of the President, that the orders contained in item (ii) of their letter dated 11-12-1961 relating to retirement benefits in so far as payment of special contribution to provident fund under the Provident Fund rules and pension and D.C.R. gratuity under the pension rules are concerned, should take effect from 22-5-1961."

**Sub.—**Officiating arrangements in place of the Officers (Non-gazetted) Deputed for training at the Central Emergency Relief Training Institute, Nagpur.

The question whether officiating arrangements should be permitted in place of non-gazetted Railway servants deputed for training at the Central Emergency Relief Training Institute, Nagpur, has been under examination of the Board, who have decided with the sanction of the President that Officiating arrangements in place of the non-gazetted staff deputed for training at the above institute, may be made, if this is considered essential in the interest of the Administration provided the duration of the course exceeds 21 days. The Board have also communicated the sanction of the President to the period of training of the officers who were/will be deputed to attend the Central Emergency Relief Training Institute, Nagpur being treated as duty under 331-R1.
