In their recommendation No. 89, the Railway Technical Training Schools Committee, 1961 have recommended that specially selected instructors and other railwaymen with a high degree of proficiency in specific fields and initial preparation in the country, may be deputed to foreign countries for short periods for further studies on specific assignments to pick up latest development in highly technical subjects.

Sub.—Continuance of the ban on creation of and recruitment to, ministerial and other categories.

Please add the following as item (7) to para 2-II of Board's letter No. E(G) 62EC2-2, dated 11-4-1962 circulated under this office endorsement No. 803-E/O/5(Eiv), dated 19-4-1962:—

"Recruitment be allowed in cases, where the posts have been lying vacant for six months or more merely due to time taken in the process of recruitment, with the personal approval of the Chief Personnel Officer and the F.A. & C.A.O."
