

Serial No. 2774. — Circular No. 743-E/O-IX(Eiv), dated 9-12-1964.

Sub — Delegation of powers — grant of extra ordinary leave.

According to item 14 of Schedules B and C of the Schedule of powers on Establishment matters, powers to grant extra ordinary leave without pay upto one year at any one time to a Railway Servant without a lien on a permanent post or holding a temporary post on a monthly rate of pay on grounds of his illness, are vested in authorities indicated against these items. The grant of extra ordinary leave to temporary Railway Servants on grounds of their own illness is subject to the conditions laid down vide notes 1 and 2 under exception II, rules 732 R1. Accordingly the following note may be inserted below item 14 of Schedules B and C.

NOTE.—The concession under this item will be admissible only to those Railway Servants who had been in continuous Railway service for a period exceeding one year.

The Schedule of Powers may please be corrected accordingly.

Sub.—Grant of extra ordinary pension/gratuity and compensation in respect of Railway servants injured or killed under Rules 2724 and 2725 R-II.
