Sub.—Revision of rates of Compensatory (Construction) Survey allowance to staff employed on construction/Survey projects on account of introduction of the revised pay structure from 1-7-1959.

A point has been raised whether those railway servants who have been drawing the allowance under para 2 (b) can draw the allowance under para. 2 (a) of that letter as and when the latter becomes favourable. The Railway Board have carefully considered the matter and have decided with the approval of the President that the staff in question may be allowed to draw the allowance under para 2 (a) if that becomes subsequently favourable.

CHAPTER VI

ORDINARY GRATUITY/PENSION ADMISSIBLE TO PERMANENT RAILWAY SERVANTS

(COMPENSATION, INVALID, SUPERANNUATION AND RETIRING)

A. Compensation Gratuity/Pension.

601. *To whom granted.* If a railway servant is selected for discharge owing to the abolition of a permanent post, he shall, unless he is appointed to another post, the conditions of service of which are deemed by the authority competent to remove him from service to be least equal to those of his own, have the option :—

- (i) of retiring from service on a compensation gratuity/pension to which he may be entitled in respect of the service he has already rendered ; or
