Sub.—Reservation for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes—Allocation of reserved vacancies to be related to a year of recruitment instead of to each occasion of recruitment.

A copy of Railway Board's letter No. E(SCT)63,CM15/16, dated 28-11-1964 is reproduced below for information and guidance :—

"In terms of the orders circulated under Board's letter No. E(SCT)63 CM15/16, dated 6-10-1964, it has been decided that the allocation of reserved vacancies should be related to a 'year of recruitment' instead of to 'each occasion of recruitment'. In this connection the Board desire to clarify that 'promotion' being a method of recruitment, the orders contained in their letter No. E(SCT)64CM15/1, dated 8-1-1964 and 16-1-64 and the letter referred to above will also apply to posts where these are reserved, in terms of the extent orders, to be filled by promotion".

Sub.—Adjudicator's Award—Monthly statement showing payment of overtime allowance paid to the staff under HER.

From the monthly statement of overtime allowance received from the Divisions and extra divisional offices, it is observed that the figures indicated therein give the picture of overtime allowance actually paid to the staff in a particular month. In fact there is considerable delay in either the staff submitting overtime slips or by the division in arranging the payment with the result that the payment made in a particular month include the overtime earned over different months and as such no conclusion can be drawn from these statements in regard to whether the overtime earned by the staff in a month is increasing or decreasing.

In order to be able to draw any conclusions from such statements, it has been decided that the overtime statements sent to this office include overtime earned by the staff in that particular month only. If the compilation of the relevant data, for various reasons, takes a long time, a gap of two months is allowed for the submission of these statements, i.e. the statement of overtime earned in November, 1964 may please be submitted in January, 1965.
