*Pension Circular No. 15 of 1966.*

**Sub.—Resignation of serving employees on their selection to posts outside Railways through the U.P.S.C.**

According to the instructions contained in para 2(A) of Railway Board's letter No. E(NG)57 RCI/56, dated 21-1-1961 applications from serving railway employees for posts outside the Railways can be forwarded on the condition that they shall sever their connections with railway in the event of their selection for outside posts. It was further clarified vide Railway Board's letter No. F(E)-621-E/1, dated 18-2-1963 that the privilege of carrying forward of leave to the temporary railway servants will be allowed only in those cases where the employees are permitted to take up appointment in the civil departments of the Central Government without resigning their railway jobs.

The Stenographers, who qualified in the U.P.S.C. Examination resigned from the railway jobs, before taking up employment in the Civil Departments of the Central Government and as such the question of transfer of their leave accounts or service records to those Departments does not arise. The particulars of service of such employees can, however, be furnished to these Departments, if and when called for.

Reference correspondence resting with your letter No. 724-E/5727 (Eiii), dated 10-9-1965 on the above subject. According Rule 2433 R-II (C.S. R. 418) as amended by C. Slip No. 192-R.-II resignation of an appointment to take up, with proper permission another appointment, whether permanent or temporary, service in which counts in full or in part, is not a resignation of public service for the

purpose of pensionary benefits, provided there is not interruption in service etc. In order to enable the new departments to count their service for the purpose of pensionary benefits the Board desire that a certificate to the effect that the employee had served on the Railway from ..... to ..... and that the liability for pensionary benefits in respect of the period of such service as may qualify for pension shall be borne by the Railway should be sent to the Departments concerned where these personnel get appointment after severing connection with the Railway.

**Sub.—Educational Assistance.**

In partial modification of the instructions contained in their letter No. E(W) 58ED1-5, dated 15-5-1958, the Board have decided that educational assistance under rule 1103 in Chapter XI of the Indian Railway Establishment Code, Volume I, should be allowed in respect of education in pre-University classes or first year classes of an Intermediate College or of a Technical College which corresponds to the XIth Class of the Higher Secondary Standard under the reorganised system.

This has the sanction of the President.
