

Serial No. 3419.—Circular No. 831-E/81-IV (Eiv), dated 26-5-1966.

A copy of the Ministry of Home Affairs Office Memorandum No. 6/8/65-Esstd. D, dated 23-2-1966 received under Railway Board's letter No. E(NG) 66RR1/6, dated 24-3-1966 is reproduced below for information and guidance.

"The undersigned is directed to say that the Government of India have decided, in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, to recognise the degrees awarded by the Mandalay University, Burma, as equivalent to the corresponding degrees of recognised Indian Universities, for purposes of appointment to services and posts under the Central Government.

2. These orders have been issued in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, in so far as appointments in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department is concerned."

Serial No. 3420.—Circular No. 561-E/222 (Eiie), dated -4-1966.

Sub.—Avenue of promotion of Typists Gr. Rs. 130-200 (AS) to Gr. 210-380 (AS).

The replies received in response to this office letter No. 961E/114/39-65/561E/222 (Eiie), NRMU, dated 31-8-1965 have been considered. As a result, it has been decided that the principles as laid down in this office letter No. 752E/361 (Eiic), dated 11-8-1965 should be followed for determining the seniority of Typists employed in Divl. and Extra Divl. Offices formed into units.

The further clarifications are also furnished below for guidance.

- (i) The seniority of typists in relevant grades be fixed as on 23-3-1965 the date of issue of orders of forming units vide this office letter No. 561E/222/(Eiie), dated 23-3-1965.
- (ii) Those promoted to higher grades prior to 23-3-1965 in respective offices will rank senior to those not promoted irrespective of their position in lower grades.
- (iii) Vacancies occurring on or after 23-3-1965 will be filled on the basis of combined seniority list to be prepared as per item 1 above.
- (iv) For the purpose of filling vacancies in the lowest grade viz. Rs. 110-180 each office will function independently as at present.

It is requested that the combined seniority lists of Typists may please be prepared without any further delay.
