Reference Board's letter No. E(G)60AL12-6, dated 22/24-4-1961, on the above noted subject. The Railway Board have decided that the eligibility of the allowance to a Railway servant will be subject to the issue of a certificate by the Administration, in addition to the certificate prescribed in the above quoted letter, to the effect that the employee concerned is likely to be posted back to the project from where he proceeded on training.

This has the sanction of the President.

The Railway Board have had under consideration the question as to whether the Railway accounts staff deputed for training to the Institute of Cost and Works Accounts, Calcutta may be allowed to draw compensatory (Construction) allowance as sanctioned in Board's letter No. E(G)57AL12-14, dated 8-5-1958 and amplified in Board's letter No. E(G)58AL12/11, dated 10-2-1959 that would have been admissible to them but for the period of their deputation on training. They have carefully considered the matter and have decided that in such cases construction allowance may be paid as a special case to the staff in question for the first four months of the period of such training subject to the certificate to be produced by the servant to the effect that he continued to incur a considerable portion of the expenditure while under training in Calcutta, for which the allowance has been sanctioned. This also disposes of Shri E. Varadachari Dy. CAO. 'G' D.O. letter No. E5/250, dated 30-3-1960 to Shri M. Sunder Raj.
