In Board's letter of even number dated 12-2-1965, it has been provided that failure to comply with the provision of any of the rules will render the railway servant drawing the advance liable to refund forthwith the whole of the amount advanced with interest accrued, unless good and sufficient reason is shown to the contrary. A question has been raised as to what further action should be taken when an employee, who is directed to refund the amount fails to refund the same. The Board desire to clarify that in such cases the recovery from the salary of the defaulting employees, may be made in the minimum number of instalments so that the net amount payable after making all deductions is not less than 50% of the basic pay (subject to the limits of payment of Wages Act).
