

**Sub: Joint Procedure Order for disposal of condemned/ abandoned Railway quarters/ buildings of masonry structure.**

There are large scale abandoned quarters on Northern Railway. Besides quarters, there are many more masonry buildings in disuse. These masonry buildings have either out lived their codal life and repair to them have become uneconomical or else can not be put to alternate use in future; such buildings are to be declared as abandoned/ condemned and need to be disposed off.

At present, there is no laid down procedure at the Zonal Railway level. Therefore, to stream line the above on this Railway, following Joint Procedure Order is issued:

1. Railway quarters & Buildings of masonry structure considered to be abandoned (keeping in mind codal life, expenditure incurred on its repair and maintenance till date) should be surveyed by an officer of Engineering Department of a rank not below Sr. Scale for declaration as condemned / abandoned and not fit for use. Some masonry buildings like cabins etc. which may be structurally sound but still not of any use in foreseeable future (to be certified by user Deptt. also); may also be classified as abandoned. These may be recommended for disposal on as is where is basis.
2. DRM may approve after satisfying himself that there is no alternative use of these quarters/masonry buildings in foreseeable future or these are otherwise unliveable/condemned.
3. Such abandoned/condemned quarters/buildings after approval by DRM, should be disposed off on "as is where is basis" after following procedures noted in paragraphs given under.
  - 3.1 Engineering, Electrical and S&T Deptt. shall remove usable fittings and material after building is declared abandoned. List of removable fittings will be signed by Jr. Scale officer of concerned Deptt. and vetted by an ISA.
  - 3.2 Engineering Department will assess the estimated value after removal of any usable Engineering material based on market rate/last accepted rates. This estimate shall have mention of approx. list of released/dismantled material and approximate cost at prevailing rates. Out of dismantled material, Division may keep provision of construction of boundary wall in mud mortar / cement mortar which may be necessary to prevent encroachment in the vacated area. The assessed value (Total value of released materials – Cost of dismantling – net cost of construction of boundary wall etc.) will be got vetted by Divisional finance.
  - 3.3 Efforts should be made to club as many buildings as possible into one tender which are indentified for dismantling and to be disposed off on 'as is where is
